Healing the Wounds Thursday March 2 | 6:30 pm EST (virtual option available) Presented by Bishop Douglas Lucia, Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse

Bishop Lucia has been advocating for Pope Francis to reject the Doctrine of Discovery. Several popes, beginning in the 15th century have advocated using the Doctrine of Discovery to justify claiming land. The Doctrine refers to a principle in public international law under which, when a nation "discovers" land, it directly acquires rights on that land. Come

Easter Season Six Week Retreat in Daily Life A Journey of Discernment with Ignatius of Loyola Thursdays, April 20, 27, May 4, 11, 18, 25 | 9:30 - 11:00 am EDT (virtual option available) Presented by Rev. Gerry McKeon, SJ

This six week retreat in daily life will encourage us to grow in our capacity to discern the presence of God in our lives. We will seek to pay attention to our experiences, and our interior moods. We will draw from the wisdom of Scripture, our daily lives, and the discernment of spirits which Ignatius of Loyola continued to explore and articulate during his own spiritual journey.

Participants will be offered suggestions for prayer each day and will also gather for six Thursdays in the Easter Season. During these group gatherings, there will be an opportunity to share the graces of the prayer during the previous week. Input will also be offered on the theme for the upcoming week of prayer. On the final weekly gathering, there will be an opportunity for each retreatant to share how he/she has developed a 'discerning heart' during these weeks of prayer. The Marise May Program in Ignatian Formation (in-person only)

Spots are going fast for our second cohort of the Marise May Program here at the Spiritual Renewal Center. This program is designed to train persons to give the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius Loyola. The first-year training will begin with a retreat day in September followed by weekly meetings beginning in October on Tuesday afternoons along with our 19th annotation program. Join Steve in a guided reading of "Thoughts in Solitude" by Thomas Merton. "Thoughts in Solitude" stands alongside *The Seven Story Mountain* as one of Merton's most enduring and popular works. Thomas Merton, a Trappist monk, is perhaps the foremost spiritual thinker of the twentieth century. His diaries, social commentary, and spiritual writings continue to be widely read after his untimely death in 1968. Our sessions will follow an informal seminar style as we engage in a close reading of the text. HORIZONS Foundational Program for the Training of Spiritual Directors (in-person only)

The Spiritual Renewal Center has been committed to the training of spiritual directors for over thirty years. Do you sense God's call to this ministry? HORIZONS is a practicum-based program for people wanting to develop their gifts as spiritual directors. Monthly sessions focus on the principles and practices of spiritual direction, alongside close supervision of direct practice. Applicants must have substantial knowledge of theology, scripture, and spirituality, and a minimum of one year's experience receiving spiritual direction.

The first year of HORIZONS meets at the Center from October 2023 through June 2024, on the first Monday of each month, 1-5:00 p.m. Tuition is \$700 per year. A certificate is awarded at the completion of the program. The Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola: A 30-week adventure in prayer (virtual option available)

The Center is offering the classic *Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius Loyola* in a thirty-week format in both a group or individual setting. After more than 500 years, the *Spiritual Exercises* still bring people to a closer relationship with Christ through the Scriptures.

Our traditional group experience will take place on Tuesdays, 1-3 PM, beginning in September and continuing through May. This includes time with an individual prayer guide and a group teaching session. Individuals that cannot meet for our in-person group format can meet with a director individually, either in person or via Zoom.

What Does Grace Look Like?

I'm always surprised by the wisdom of St. Ignatius. I have used his teachings in spiritual direction for many years to help people who are making tough decisions. I was directing a young woman who was facing a very tough situation in her life and was trying to figure out what to do. We had looked at it from many angles and I could see that she was feeling stuck and hopeless. Using a common technique, I asked her what advice she might give to a friend in the same situation. She attempted to do that but we didn't get very far.

Then I decided to extend it. This woman had lost a dear friend, who had been a mentor and guide during her adolescence, just a few years earlier in a tragic car accident. She had spoken about how important this friend was to her and that she felt truly loved and supported by her. So I said, "You know that Julie loved you and wanted what was best for you." "Yes," she replied. "What would she say to you right now? Can you imagine her speaking to you?" The young woman's body visibly relaxed and a look of calm came over her face. I was surprised at the change. At once she knew what to do. Hearing the voice of someone she loved through imaginative prayer seemed to open up a new space for the Spirit to rush in.




