Welcome Our New Director, Rev. Dr. Steve Moore



Dear Friends,

What an honor it is to be chosen as the second director of the Spiritual Renewal Center. I know that I stand on the shoulders of giants who have built and sustained this vibrant ministry over the past 43 years. It is my prayer that we continue this legacy by reading the signs of the times and meeting the challenge of our current moment. I first learned about the Center when I took a class with Jim Krisher as a junior at LeMoyne College. Over the years I had attended some of the programs offered and was happy to become a staff

spiritual director four years ago after running into Jim and Debbie at the meeting of the International Thomas Merton Society at St. Bonaventure's in Olean.

I have been involved in the ministry of spiritual direction as a director for over twenty years. I took my first course in spiritual direction at St. Bernard's in Albany in 2001 and then went on to do the retreat director's workshop at Loyola House in Guelph the same year. I completed my theological studies at Theological College at the Catholic University of America and also at Church Divinity School of the Pacific at the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley. I completed the certificate in spiritual direction through the Haden Institute at Mount Carmel Spiritual Center in Niagara Falls in 2010. Currently, I am in the process of completing my Doctor of Ministry degree at Colgate Rochester Crozier Divinity School in Rochester.

In addition, I am also a clinical psychologist. I did my graduate studies in psychology at the California School of Professional Psychology in San Francisco and my internship at Hutchings Psychiatric Center here in Syracuse. Most recently I have been working as the staff psychologist on the Adolescent Inpatient Psychiatry unit at Upstate University Hospital. Since coming to Syracuse, I have served St. John's Episcopal Church in Marcellus as their parish priest.

I grew up in Hudson Falls, NY and my parents, my two brothers, as well as most of my extended family still lives in that area. My wife Erin is the chorus and music teacher at Christian Brother's Academy, as well as the music minister at St. John's and the Saturday evening musician at St. Lucy's in Syracuse, where she also serves on the parish council. Yet our most important vocation is to be the parents of James, Miriam and Elizabeth. James is beginning second grade and Miriam is beginning Kindergarten. Our two-year-old Eliza is still in daycare and is learning to make her needs known.

I have been blessed to be part of the Spiritual Renewal Center as a spiritual director and occasional speaker. I am very much looking forward to getting to know many of you in my new role. Coming out of a global pandemic, we are faced with many new opportunities and challenges. The Center's mission and values are needed now more than ever and I look forward to sharing with you all in this exciting ministry.

Update on Mask Guidance at the Center

As many of you are aware we are in an ever-changing situation with regards to the coronavirus pandemic. Most recently, the Delta variant of the virus has been found to spread among both the unvaccinated and vaccinated at high rates making it far more contagious than previous strains of the virus. In light of this finding, the Center for Disease Control has issued the guideline that masks be worn by all people regardless of vaccination status, when indoors in areas where there is significant transmission of the virus.

We just learned that the virus is again spreading at a significant rate in Onondaga county and the surrounding regions. In an effort to protect ourselves, our loved ones and our community, the Spiritual Renewal Center will now require that all persons, regardless of vaccination status, wear masks when inside the Center. We do this both for safety reasons and for promotion of the common good in keeping with public health recommendations during these difficult times.

We know that this causes a hardship for those of us who were looking forward to a return to "normal." The Spiritual Renewal Center remains open as a place of welcome and renewal for all. Thank you for your cooperation and let us continue to hold one another in prayer.

What Does Grace Look Like? is a series of reflections about God's grace. This issue's grace story comes from Steve Moore, newly appointed Center Director and spiritual director.

What Does Grace Look Like?

I was about thirteen years old and had just finished serving mass at our small daily mass chapel in my parish. I was sitting there alone and I was angry. My parents were going through a terrible divorce and I felt like my world was falling apart. I was starting to shut down emotionally and push people away. I was also furious at God for letting this happen to me.

Suddenly an image came to my mind of a brick wall. I came to understand that I had to make a choice, here and now about how I was going to live my life. I could try to protect myself by constructing a wall around me or I could go the other way and be vulnerable to being hurt.

I decided that I did not want to have a wall around me and chose to be vulnerable. In that moment I had a sense that God was powerfully present as a parent and guide, which is what I most needed at the time. Looking back, I see this as one of the pivotal decision points in my life where God invited me into a deeper relationship and also gave me the freedom to decide.

Are You Interested in Becoming a Spiritual Director?

The Spiritual Renewal Center has been committed to the training of spiritual directors for over thirty years. Have you been sensing God's call to this ministry?


HORIZONS is a two-year practicum-based program for people wanting to develop their gifts as spiritual directors. Monthly sessions focus on the principles and practices of spiritual direction, alongside close supervision of direction practice. Applicants must have substantial knowledge in theology, scripture, and spirituality, and a minimum of one year's experience receiving spiritual direction.

The first year of HORIZONS meets at the Center October 2021 through June 2022, on the first Monday of each month, 1-5:15 pm. During the second year (also October through June on the first Mondays), monthly sessions are 2:45-5:15 pm. Tuition is \$700 per year. Instructors include Jim Krisher, Sr. Marise May, Rev. Dr. Steve Moore, and Rev. John Rose - all experienced staff spiritual directors at the Center. A certificate is awarded at the completion of the program. This fall's cohort is forming; inquire by September 17 to mail@spiritualrenewalcenter.com for more details or an application. Distance learning may be possible depending on interest.
